Prayer Wall FAQs

Here are answers to some *Frequently Asked Questions* that can help you begin using our Prayer Wall.

1. How do I submit a prayer request?

Simply click on SHARE YOUR PRAYER REQUEST, and fill in the simple form that appears. Then, indicate how you wish to share your request and whether you want to be notified by email when someone indicates they're praying as you requested. Lastly, click I'm not a robot (that is, you are a real person and not a computer sending spam), and SUBMIT REQUEST. It's easy.

2. How do I know when someone prays for me?

You can choose to be notified so that you know when people pray for you. Every time someone clicks "I Prayed For This" you will receive an email to let you know.

3. Can I use this for urgent requests, from wherever I am?

Yes! You can use this from your cell phone and iPad. Going for surgery that day or to interview for a job and you want praying for you? Post it from wherever you are, and know you're being lifted up.

4. How can I let people praying for me know that their prayers were answered?

When submitting your prayer request, you will receive a confirming email with a link for indicating when the prayer has been answered.

5. In time, I might want to remove my prayer request. How can I do that?

Same as with prayers being answered. When submitting your prayer request, you will receive a confirming email with a link for removing your prayer request.

6. How public will my prayer request be?

When submitting your prayer request, you are given three options:

Share This ~ This option allows your request to be listed on our Prayer Wall with your name. Our Friday Prayer Team that prays before the Bless Sacrament and parish staff will pray for you, too.

Share This Anonymously ~ Your request will not include your name when listed on our Prayer Wall and given to others for prayer.

DO NOT Share This ~ Your request will not be listed on our Prayer Wall, but will be prayed for at Friday Mass and by parish staff and several prayer groups. However, your name will not be included.

7. Does my request get posted immediately?

Almost. Your request will be sent to us, and we will then post it shortly thereafter. This is to prevent spam from being posted.

8. How can I learn of new prayer requests?

You can check the Prayer Wall page, or use the link on the page to subscribe to an RSS feed.
